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INTRODUCTION

The Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003 (PREA) was enacted to address and combat sexual abuse and harassment in federal, state, and local institutions. PREA aims to eliminate, reduce, and prevent such misconduct by implementing a zero-tolerance policy in prisons, community confinement facilities, and local jails.

CURA, Inc. is dedicated to maintaining a safe and secure environment, free from all forms of sexual misconduct and retaliation. CURA, Inc. continuously monitors policies and procedures to comply with PREA standards and provides education to staff, volunteers, contractors, and residents.

The CURA, Inc. RCRP facility received its initial PREA certification on September 28, 2015, meeting all standards and underscoring our strong commitment to preventing, detecting, and responding to sexual abuse and harassment.

This report details allegations reported between January 1, 2022, and December 31, 2022.

PURPOSE

The Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) requires data to be collected and reviewed on sexual abuse and sexual harassment incidents, annually. CURA, Inc. will analyze the PREA data to assess and improve the effectiveness of its sexual abuse prevention, detection, and response policies, and training.

DEFINITIONS

Substantiated - Investigation determined that the allegation occurred.

Unsubstantiated - Investigation determined incident may have occurred, but there was insufficient evidence to prove the allegation

Unfounded - Investigation determined incident did not occur

On-going Investigations - Investigation has not been completed
